

10-MINUTE BIBLE LESSON

A Busy Day

Genesis 1:9-13

Before watching the video: read this passage twice. Take time to notice each sentence and phrase. What do you notice about it? What questions do you have?

And God said, "Let the waters under the sky be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear." And it was so. God called the dry land Earth, and the waters that were gathered together he called Seas. And God saw that it was good. Then God said, "Let the earth put forth vegetation: plants yielding seed, and fruit trees of every kind on earth that bear fruit with the seed in it." And it was so. The earth brought forth vegetation: plants yielding seed of every kind, and trees of every kind bearing fruit with the seed in it. And God saw that it was good. And there was evening and there was morning, the third day. – Genesis 1:9-13

Now watch the video. What new information did you learn? How does it change your understanding of the passage?

After further containing the waters of disorder mentioned in previous studies, here is the first appearance of dry land and, more significantly, the first sign of life in the form of plants, vegetation, and fruit trees. Can you think of a moment when, during a time of chaos in your own life, signs of life and renewal began to emerge? Where are you still looking for such life now?

Conclude in prayer. Thank God for blessings, ask forgiveness for wrongs done, request help for uncertainty. Close with "amen."
