

10-MINUTE BIBLE LESSON

Still Providing

Genesis 3:20-24

Before watching the video: what do you believe about how the universe began? What did you learn in science classes or in a religious tradition? If you've ever heard about, been taught about, or read Genesis 3, what have you believed or assumed it says or means?

Now read the passage twice. Take your time to notice every sentence and phrase. What stands out to you?

The man named his wife Eve, because she was the mother of all living.

And the Lord God made garments of skins for the man and for his wife, and clothed them.

Then the Lord God said, "See, the man has become like one of us, knowing good and evil; and now, he might reach out his hand and take also from the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"— therefore the Lord God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from which he was taken. He drove out the man; and at the east of the garden of Eden he placed the cherubim, and a sword flaming and turning to guard the way to the tree of life. – ***Genesis 3:20-24***

After watching the video, think further about how God keeps providing for the man and woman, including giving them clothing. Even though the nature of it changes, God remains in relationship with what God has created. Why do you think that is important?

Think back over what you have learned during this study series. What surprised you? What do you want to still learn more about? How can you build on what you've learned?

Conclude in prayer. Thank God for blessings, ask forgiveness for wrongs done, request help for uncertainty. Close with "amen."
